5. Promote and defend a culture of good governance, democratic principles and institutions, popular participation, human rights and freedoms as well as social justice as its affect the minority
6. Promote, advocate and defend a culture of gender equality;
7. Promote and strengthen the institutional, human and operational capacities of the minority's non-governmental organizations.

Our Successes

In the last nine years, The African Humanitarian Council has provided over 500,000 tons of food and clothing, 4,000 turkey dinners at Thanksgiving, and over 40,000 toys to families in need. Also over 25,000 Back-to-School packages distributed, 500 teenagers have completed our Drug Awareness program. Additionally, we have also provided free auto care services to the hundreds of elderly and single parents, 100 adults have graduated from our Faith Based Drug Rehabilitation programs. Internationally, since our inception we have undertaken fifteen medical missions to Africa to provide medical treatment to underprivileged individuals and families living in the rural areas of Nigeria. The organization has shipped 12 forty-foot containers of medical supplies and equipments, books, and other household items to Africa and Haiti. We have provided bore-hole water to villages in Africa.
